## IELTS writing task 2: the basics

- Writing task 2 is more of an argumentative and expository type.
- You should write 250 words minimum on an argumentative prompt followed by a couple of questions.
- There are majorly 5 types of essays. Make sure which one you are facing.
- There are no serious differences between General and Academic in WT2.
- You have 40 minutes on this task compared to 20 minutes in T1. It means T2 is twice as much important as T1. So, start your writing part with T2.
- Make sure you keep the academic format of a writing; that is, introduction, body paragraphs and conclusion.

What are the characteristics of argumentative and expository writing?

- Argument refers to the ability to convince someone to see things from your specific vantagepoint.
- In expository genre, it is common to collect and synthesize information. This type of writing is often objective, like reports



#### How to build an argument in a writing

- Prior to building an argument you should know that writing is a more sophisticated style of communication than speaking. To build an argument you should follow a number of rules:
- Your writing should have the academic style.
- The ideas should be openly known to everyone.
- There should be one big idea in the writing. you had better take side with either of the argument's side. Middle positions are just hard to follow.
- Iranian's tendency is to jump from one topic to another, or present the issue in disguise. That is inappropriate in English.


